## DEL FRISCO'S STEAKHOUSE CHICAGO

Cachet Wine Cellar Design and Manufacture proudly designed and built the iconic four-storyglass wine tower at the center of Del Frisco's Double Eagle Steakhouse in Chicago.

This striking glass-enclosed cellar not only serves as a dramatic architectural statement butalso functions as a fully climate-controlled wine storage system, engineered with precision forlong-term performance in a high-traffic commercial environment.

Beyond the main tower, Cachet also crafted three additional custom wine cellars throughout the restaurant. Each installation combines traditional woodworking with sleek modern design,reflecting Cachet's dedication to expert craftsmanship, functionality, and refined aesthetics.

- · 4-story, floor-to-ceiling glass-enclosed wine cellar
- All-heart redwood wine racking with a mix of traditional craftsmanship and contemporary styling
- Integrated VintageView metal wine displays for modern vertical presentation
- 38,000 BTU commercial-grade cooling system tailored to the scale and glass enclosure
- Custom-built spiral staircase providing access across all four levels
- Storage for both standard 750ml and Magnum bottles, with high-reveal display rows and quarter-round racks


# PALAZZO LAS VEGAS

Cachet Wine Cellar Design and Manufacture created a luxurious custom wine cabinet installation forthe high-stakes poker room at The Palazzo Gaming Lounge in Las Vegas.

Crafted from lacquered white oak, the project includes temperature-controlled wine cabinets and a Spanish cedar-lined cigar humidor—both designed to complement the upscale setting. Custom wineracks and insulated white oak doors complete the refined aesthetic.

This installation highlights Cachet's dedication to blending craftsmanship, performance, and luxury in commercial wine storage.

- Custom commercial wine cabinets crafted from white oak with a lacquer finish
- · 700-bottle capacity with horizontal display racking
- Three red wine cabinets (stored at 55°F) and one white wine cabinet (stored at 45°F)
- Integrated CellarPro Ducted Self-Contained Cooling Units for precise temperature and humidity control
- White oak wine room doors with airtight insulation and secure locking mechanisms
- Low-heat LED and channel lighting for energy-efficient visual enhancement
- Built-in humidor crafted from white oak and lined with Spanish cedar, featuring the CWC Humidification System













## RITZ CARLTON LAGUNA NIGUEL

We are proud to showcase this striking floor-to-ceiling glass wine cellar, custom-built for the 5-star Ritz-Carlton Hotel in Laguna Beach, California.

Designed as both a functional storage solution and a visual centerpiece, this modern installationelevates the hotel's luxury hospitality experience through thoughtful design and precise engineering.

Crafted from stained and lacquered alder, the cabinets feature black metal wine racks withhorizontal displays and a rolling library ladder for access.

Adjacent to the cellar is a dedicated cheese and chocolate room, maintained at approximately 65%humidity.

Towering at 18 feet, this installation exemplifies elegance, performance, and expertcraftsmanship.

- 18-ft floor-to-ceiling glass enclosure with dual-pane framed glass
- Custom alder wood wine cabinets with black metal racks
- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$  Rolling library ladder for easy access to upper storage
- · Horizontal racking for 250+ wine varieties

## FAIRMONT HOTEL CHICAGO

Cachet Wine Cellar Design and Manufacture created this elegant 10-foot-tall custom wine cabinet for the renowned Fairmont Hotel in Millennium Park, Downtown Chicago.

Crafted from stained and lacquered white oak with unfinished mahogany interior racking, the cabinet features a rolling oak library ladder for easy access and timeless appeal.

Designed for ENO Wine Bar, the cellar holds over 500 wine varieties, includes guest wine lockers,and even offers a dedicated cheese storage compartment. This award-winning installation reflects Cachet's focus on craftsmanship, functionality, and luxuryin commercial wine storage.

- 10-foot-tall custom wine cabinet crafted from stained and lacquered white oak
- · Interior wine racking in unfinished mahogany
- Finished oak rolling library ladder with dual handles for elegant access
- · Over 500 wine varieties stored and displayed
- Individual wine lockers for guests, adding a personalized luxury experience
- · Built-in cheese storage compartment
- Ducted split cooling system, seamlessly concealed in the ceiling













## NICCO'S DURANGO RESORT LAS VEGAS

Inside Durango Casino & Resort upscale Nicco's Steakhouse, a grand high-ceiling custom winecellar makes a bold impression.

Guests can admire the dramatic glass entrance or explore the curated collection up close, allwhile enjoying a dining experience elevated by this visually striking installation.

The dual-zone cellar holds up to 4,000 bottles in temperature-controlled conditions—separatelyoptimized for reds and whites.

Rolling ladders allow access to the 15-foot-tall racking system, combining functionality, craftsmanship, and premium ambiance to support a standout wine program.

- · Floor-to-ceiling white oak racks reaching 15 feet tall
- Capacity to store approximately 4,000 bottles, including magnums
- Dual climate zones: 55°F for reds and 40–45°F for whites
- · Custom rolling ladders for easy access to upper racks
- Variety of racking styles: crate storage, single-depth racks, and illuminated reveal rows
- Massive gold-plated framed glass door with precise sealing
- Specialized metal horizontal racks for optimal bottle display

## HELL'S KITCHEN SAN DIEGO

At Hell's Kitchen San Diego, Cachet Wine Cellar Design and Manufacture created a striking, multi-section custom wine cellar that enhances the restaurant's dramatic interior with both function and flair. The first two connected sections hold a total of 2,500 bottles and are designed with dual functionality: the upper display features empty bottles showcased behind frameless glass purely for visual impact, while the lower section is temperature-controlled and built for long-term wine storage. The base includes acrylic double-deep racks with horizontal layout, brushed posts, and a marble stone platform. Two brushed metal ladders provide elegant and practical access to the upper levels.

The entire wine cabinet is cooled by a ducted split system, maintaining a quiet 55°F environment through dual-pane glass for optimal preservation. The third section, dedicated exclusively to champagne, maintains a cooler 40°F climate. This champagne room holds about 400 bottles in a two-sided cabinet crafted from walnut wood and brushed metal posts. Designed for both aesthetic impact and storage performance, this cellar reflects Cachet's signature blend of engineering precision and elevated design.

- · Multi-zone cellar with total capacity of ~2,900 bottles
- Upper display zone (non-refrigerated) behind frameless glass for visual appeal
- Lower section with acrylic double-deep horizontal racks and brushed posts
- · Marble base and two brushed ladders for bottle access
- Ducted split cooling system, maintaining 55°F quietly with dual-pane glass
- Champagne room (40°F) with two-sided walnut and brushed metal cabinetry
- · Functional design meets bold restaurant aesthetics
